This Sangiovese has a glistening strawberry plum color. There is a great nose of raspberry and blackberry, followed by the taste of dried bing cherries, and a light oak toast. Although still young this wine is already showing the smoothing of its typical Sangiovese edges. This wine can go well with a vast range of foods, italian sausage pizza, bufala tomato salad, or a chilled mix of watermelon and feta. This is a fun wine to pair with, since it pairs well with so many delicious foods.
